

LAT Decision Summary

Applicant: Noel Thomas Watt
Released: January 11, 2001
Appeal Date: February 12, 2001

Disposition: Registration revoked
Keywords: Industry-specific convictions, theft and forgery convictions, falsified application, tax evasion, breach of terms and conditions, non-disclosure, Brenner and Fascenda

Summary:

The Applicant breached his 1997 Registrar's terms and conditions by failing to seek the Registrar's consent for his change of employment. The Applicant also failed to disclose his previous criminal and tax convictions on this 1999 renewal application and subsequently on a further request for particulars. In an attempt to remedy the non-disclosure issue, the Applicant also provided a false document (an application form) to the Registrar's office.

The Tribunal agreed with the aforementioned evidence and found the Registrar had satisfied the onus of proof that the past conduct of the Applicant afforded reasonable grounds for revocation.

Registration revoked.
