

LAT Decision Summary

Applicant: Roderick James Williamson
Released: June 13, 2003

Disposition: Registration refused
Keywords: Criminal convictions, non-disclosure on application, outstanding arrest warrant

Summary:

The Applicant completed and signed an application for registration as a motor vehicle salesperson on November 13, 2002.

Registration was refused based on the applicant's criminal record and failure to make full disclosure of his criminal record on previous applications for registration. The applicant also had an outstanding warrant for his arrest.

"The Tribunal finds that the Registrar has established on a balance of probabilities that the applicant has recently been convicted of fraud, an industry specific offence. There is a warrant for his arrest for the Fraud Over and the applicant is on probation involving a recognizance relating to a Family Law Act Restraining Order ... The applicant's very recent and past conduct raises a strong concern, which requires the protection of the public."

Registration refused.
