Summary:

The applicant applied for registration as a salesperson on October 23, 2003. On that application he indicated he had been found guilty or convicted of an offence, but did not provide particulars. When asked to provide full details of all convictions, the applicant failed to do so.

The applicant continued to work as a salesperson for Willowdale Dodge despite being informed by the Registrar he was not allowed to do so. He did not to disclose his convictions to Willowdale Dodge until it became necessary.

"The applicant's non-disclosure in his application to be registered as a salesperson is of great concern to the Tribunal. The Motor Vehicle Dealers Act is a public protection statute and the Registrar bases his decision on whether or not to grant or refuse a licence, in part, on the responses given by the applicant. The applicant's non-disclosure amounts to material misrepresentation to the Registrar and thus to the public."

Registration refused.
