MVDA 2002 Implementation Date Changed to January 2010

Dear Registrant,

The Ministry of Small Business and Consumer Services has announced that implementation of the new Motor Vehicle Dealers Act, 2002 (MVDA 2002) has been delayed until **January 2010**. The new Act was originally expected to launch **April 1, 2009**.

The extended implementation period comes in response to concerns expressed by the industry.

Over the last few months OMVIC has issued bulletins and newsletters outlining the changes to expect under MVDA 2002. A series of information sessions are also being conducted for dealers and salespeople throughout Ontario. Leading up to the new implementation date, we will continue to provide updates and information for you.
