

## A-Protect Auto Warranty Corporation is **NOT** “OMVIC Bonded”

A-Protect Warranty Corporation advertises on its website that it, or its products, are “OMVIC BONDED”. A-Protect is **not** “bonded” by OMVIC nor does OMVIC endorse or recommend A-Protect Auto Warranty.

A-Protect did request permission to use the OMVIC logo on its website; this permission was denied. Despite this denial the company has used the OMVIC logo to advertise and claim they are “OMVIC Bonded”.

OMVIC has put the company on notice that it must immediately cease the use of the OMVIC name, logo, or the fictitious “OMVIC BONDED” logo in association with A-Protect Auto Warranties. Further legal action will be taken as necessary.

Under the MVDA extended warranties must be backed financially in one of two ways: insurance or an irrevocable letter of credit to the Motor Vehicle Dealers Compensation Fund. A-Protect Auto Warranty Corporation warranties are not insured however the company has provided the Fund with the required letter of credit. This however may not be construed as “bonding” nor should it in anyway way indicate OMVIC endorses a product.

Dealers and consumers are advised to be wary of any advertisement or claim which infers a product or service is endorsed by OMVIC.
