UPDATE: MOTOR VEHICLE DEALERS ACT, 2002 REGULATIONS ARE NOW AVAILABLE

We recently advised you that the Motor Vehicle Dealers Act, 2002 (MVDA 2002) will become law on **April 1, 2009**. The Ministry of Small Business and Consumer Services has now officially released the Regulations under the new Act. Regulations contain far more detail concerning the application of the Act.

The current Motor Vehicle Dealers Act, as well as the new MVDA 2002, governs the business practices of Ontario's motor vehicle dealers and salespeople. OMVIC will have the same role when MVDA 2002 goes into effect.

What happens next?

Leading up to the April 1, 2009 implementation date OMVIC will be issuing information about the new Act and your obligations as a dealer. We will keep you posted with regular updates.
